Trip to Oregon!



One month until Arrows travels to India! God has called us to India, and He is going to do some incredible things on this trip! Several of our members have been before, and God moved in amazing ways then, but we are praying to see even more miraculous things happen this trip. We will mostly be in the areas of Mumbai and Chennai, performing on stages, in churches, orphanages, schools, and even the dirt streets! We will also be performing and ministering at a huge youth conference (10,000+ expected!!) alongside the band Hillsong. Arrows is unique because we can speak to all nations through our language and passion of dance. This is our window to impact the nations, and we intend on bursting through making that window a double door.

There is still so much to be done, and a huge sum of funds to be raised. The trip will cost \$3500 per person, and 12 out of our 14 member company are going. I've raised about \$800 thus far, and I am so very grateful for those of you who have supported me! I still need a good majority of my funds. We are holding four fundraisers this month before we leave; however, splitting that between 12 of us will be a stretch. So, I need your help! Please join us in prayer for safety in traveling, as well as performing. We have a hectic schedule in India, so prayers for rest and rejuvenation are also going to be needed (because who knows how much sleep we'll actually be able to get!). Our prayer is to do as much work for the Kingdom as we can, and we fully believe God will show up and change lives!!
