After getting confirmation from our India connections, our directors made the decision to postpone out trip until Feb. 14 – Mar. 3. This actually means we get to stay a bit longer than originally planned, and I think even visit an extra city or two.

The team as a whole felt peace about this decision, and many had been feeling the same, that it wasn't the right timing; but we were all still willing to go.

My ankle has been one of the injuries, so please pray for complete cooperation and healing. Lastly, tour! Please continue to join me in praying that all the tour details will be finalized, and that the right people will be in the right places at the right time for us to minister to. We want to be as effective as possible!
